ANDREA BIGANO

Scientist at Fondazione Eni Enrico Mattei, Euro-Mediterranean Center for Climate Change

Andrea Bigano holds a Ph.D. in Economics from the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven, (Belgium) a M.Sc. in Environmental Economics from the University College London (UK), and a degree in Economics from Università Commerciale Luigi Bocconi, (Milan, Italy).

He is Senior Researcher at Fondazione Eni Enrico Mattei where he contributes to research on energy markets and policy, renewable energy, externalities, modelling of climate change impacts on the world economy and, in particular, on the interactions between climate change and tourism. On this issue, he has contributed to the development of a model of worldwide changes in tourist flows and tourist expenditures as a consequence of climate change, and to the general economic equilibrium modelling of the impacts of changes in tourism patterns due to climate change.

Andrea Bigano is affiliate scientist of the Italian “Euromediterranean Center for Climate Change” (CMCC) and has worked as consultant at Ref., (www.ref-online.it), as scientific consultant for the Abdus Salam International Centre for Theoretical Physics an UNESCO research centre based in Trieste, Italy (www.ictp.it), and as researcher at the Centre for Economic Studies, Katholieke Universiteit Leuven Belgium (www.econ.kuleuven.ac.be).

Andrea Bigano is deputy coordinator of the SECURE project (on energy security). In the past he has been scientific supervisor of the CHINA project (on international energy policy comparisons), has coordinated a project on energy efficiency in Italy and has contributed to the CASES and NEEDS (both on energy social costs), and to the ClimChAlp, KYOTO, IMPACTS and Italy-USA projects (on climate change).
