## **DAVID HOBBS**

Head of Research at King Abdullah Petroleum Studies And Research Centre

David Hobbs is the Head of Research at the King Abdullah Petroleum Studies And Research Centre (KAPSARC). Prior to joining the Centre, he was both Chief Energy Strategist and Head of Research at IHS CERA. He is an expert in energy industry structure and strategies and author of several studies and analyses on important energy issues ranging from the oil value chain to the impact of natural gas supplies on energy markets and technology and the effect on job creation and economic growth of energy industry investment activities. Through his career he has directed projects in Asia, South America, North America, and the North Sea, as well as led major international investment and asset commercialization programs. He also produced a report on the world economic crisis for the Ministerial meeting in London hosted by UK Prime Minister Gordon Brown and has advised on several projects on topics including the Canadian oil sands, clean energy and national energy strategies. He is an adjunct professor at the University of Calgary and was on the management board of the Global Energy Executive MBA program run jointly between the Haskayne School of Business and IHS CERA. He is also a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the Fondazione Eni Enrico Mattei (FEEM). He holds a degree in Petroleum Engineering from Imperial College London.
