She has fifteen years of professional experience from research on environment and development, including five years as a manager. Her main research interests are in the fields or ecohydrology and environmental physics, with a special attention to water flows in terrestrial ecosystems. Water resources interventions in small scale agriculture in the tropics is one of her focus areas.

Recently, the quantifications of inter-linkages (nexus) between the agriculture, energy and water sectors and the environment has been the focus of her work, including facilitation of dialogue between multistakeholder groups in low-income countries.
