As Photoactive Materials Project Manager, his activity is mainly devoted to the development of new materials for Luminescent Solar Concentrators, optical devices aimed to increase the efficiency of solar cells and to reduce the cost of photovoltaic energy. As Eni P.I., Fusco is supervisor of two Eni/MIT joined projects on the design of new materials for solar energy capture and storage.
